Preliminary Information for New Clients of the Uelzen Food Bank (Uelzer Tafel e.V.)

- We are pleased that you are helping to prevent food waste.
- All staff members of the Uelzen Food Bank work on a voluntary basis and without pay.
- Therefore, we ask that you treat our staff with courtesy and respect.
- Over 130 people work so that we can distribute food to our clients.
- The food from the food bank is often past its best-before date – it is donated by businesses. This food can still be eaten or drunk. However, we recommend checking the quality by smelling and tasting it.
- Visual changes may occur – but these do not affect the value of the food.
- Anyone wishing to become a client of the Uelzen Food Bank must not exceed certain income limits. This will be verified by submitting official documents.
- Applications can be picked up or dropped off on Wednesdays and Saturdays between 12:30 p.m. and 1:30 p.m.
- If there are no application-related questions, no one needs to be present before 1:30 p.m. – in fact, numbers can be drawn until 3:00 p.m.
- **The first client receives the same amount of goods as the last client – no one is disadvantaged.**
- Clients agree to abide by the house rules (see application form):
 - a. Driving cars or bicycles on the premises is not permitted.
 - b. Intoxicated or otherwise impaired persons will be refused entry.
 - c. Pushing or shoving will result in exclusion from the food bank.

Important information - please read!

In order to receive food from the Uelzer Tafel, it is a prerequisite that the monthly income is below the limit for basic income support (*for 2026 1381,00 € per month for single persons, in each case plus supplements for family members, incl. other state support if applicable*).

For the creation of the ID card must be brought to the next visit to the Uelzer Tafel:

- Application filled in completely and legibly
- Identity card, passport or other document with photo
- Proof of existing income, e.g.
 - o Citizen benefit or Hartz IV notice,
 - o Pension notice,
 - o Bafög notice,
 - o Salary Statement,
 - o Care Allowance Verification,
 - o Benefits under the Asylum Seekers Act,
 - o Other proof of indigence

During the exchange campaign from the old to the new ID cards (July-September 2023), there is no cost for Tafel customers.

A passport photo/photograph is not required to create the ID card.

The new ID card will be issued 1 week after the application is submitted - then the old ID card must be returned.

As of October 2023, a fee of 2.00 euros will be charged for the loss or re-issuance of the Tafel ID card.

A donation of €1.00 per pick-up is expected for food drop-off.

Generally, only one food pickup per week is allowed per ID card holder.

The Tafel ID card and a valid photo ID (*ID card, passport, driver's license*) must be shown each time food is picked up.

Information sheet Data Protection Uelzer Tafel e.V.

The provision of your personal data is absolutely necessary to carry out the food distribution. This data is processed based on your consent.

The issuing association is tax-privileged because of the promotion of charitable purposes and is therefore obliged to only provide benefits to those in need within the meaning of the law. The association must do this to the financial administration if necessary. can also prove. Therefore, your personal data must be stored for up to six years after the end of your clientele for tax reasons as proof of non-profit status. If the Tafel is exempt from this obligation, your data will be deleted as soon as you are no longer a customer of the Tafel or have not appeared at the issue for more than 12 months.

If you then want to become a customer again, you will need to enter your data again.

We currently store:

- Place of residence Street, postal code, town
- Number of adult and minor household members and their names and dates of birth
- Day of possible issue (Wednesday, Saturday), permitted place of issue
- Proof of need provided (date); - Date of application (date); Day of ID issue (date)
- Your marital status ; e-mail address ; - phone number ; Nationality
- possibly Eating habits such as vegetarian or similar

Your data will not be shared with third parties.

As a customer, you have the right to information about the personal data concerning you and to its correction, deletion, restriction of processing, objection to processing and the right to data portability at any time.

You can object by post to: Uelzer Tafel e.V. – Bohldamm 65 29525 Uelzen judge.

You have the right to complain to the competent data protection authority at any time.

Information about the Uelzer Tafel distribution

Dear customers of the Uelzer Tafel on Nothmannstrasse!

Please note the following:

- Numbers will be distributed on Wednesdays and Saturdays from 12:30 p.m. to 3:00 p.m. Waiting numbers will be drawn at the distribution machine.
- It doesn't matter who has the first or last number: the number of products each cardholder receives is the same. No one has to wait in line early – early birds have no advantage.
- Entry to the entire premises (see diagram) is only permitted from 12:30 p.m. All participants are asked not to enter the premises before 12:30 p.m.
- A donation of at least €1.00 is still requested for the food distribution.
- The consumption of alcohol on the premises is strictly prohibited. Persons consuming alcohol may be removed from their seats and excluded from the table. Individuals who are heavily intoxicated may also be removed.
- Riding bicycles on the premises is prohibited.
- Stopping or parking customer vehicles on the premises is prohibited. Anyone found staying or parking without permission will be subject to a €40.00 fine from the property owner.
- A new white ID card with a code and a photo ID must be presented.
- New ID cards can be requested between 12:30 p.m. and 13:30 p.m. on the distribution days.
- Violation of the bylaws may result in expulsion from the board.
